



IADVL KARNATAKA QUIZZATHON 2024-2025

The IADVL Karnataka Quizzathon 2024-2025 was a highly successful, ten-month-long academic competition. Launched as a Presidential Initiative by Dr. Manjunath Hulmani (President IADVL KN)and expertly crafted by Dr. Ashwini P K (IADVL Karnataka Academy Chairperson), the program engaged the postgraduates across the state from December 2024 to September 2025. The format, which included monthly online preliminary rounds and online main events, fostered competitive learning, attracting more than 100 teams monthly from various medical colleges.The mains was conducted on zoom platform and postgraduates across the country were able to view and be a part of this monthly academic feast.

Program Structure and Scale

The Quizzathon was characterized by its extensive reach and consistent monthly schedule:

- **Duration:** 10 months (December 2024 – September 2025).
- **Participation:** Over 100 teams participated each month.
- **Format:** Online prelims selected the top four teams, who then advanced to the monthly main rounds. Different dermatology topics were chosen each month to ensure comprehensive coverage.

The initiative's success was heavily supported by a dedicated group of ten Quiz Masters from across the state who conducted the monthly events: Dr. Sahana Srihari, Dr. Vinutha R, Dr. Namitha Chathra, Dr. Mihika Noronha, Dr. Ambresh S Badad, Dr. Mohan Shendre, Dr. Jyothi Jayaraman, Dr. Heera Ramesh, Dr. Malcolm Pinto, and Dr. Akshay Samagani.

The results from the 10-month Quizzathon reflect an intense, high-level competition among dermatology post-graduates across the state.

1. Institutional Performance and Final Standings

The final scorecard highlights the most dominant institutions across the entire 10-month period.

- Bangalore Medical College finished as the definitive leader, accumulating 100 points, 35 points clear of the next competitor.
- JNMC, Belgaum demonstrated the highest level of competitive consistency over the entire duration, appearing in the Top 4 in 5 out of 10 months.

3. Academic Year Analysis

The results show participation and success across all post-graduate years (PG years 1, 2, and 3):

- **3rd-Year PG Teams:** Dominated the early part of the Quizzathon, securing 1st place in December, January, March, and May. This suggests that senior residents utilized their accumulated knowledge effectively.
- **2nd-Year PG Teams:** Had strong wins, securing 1st place in February, July, and August.
- **1st-Year PG Teams:** Achieved a major win in June, indicating quick adaptation and solid foundation-level knowledge among the newest residents.

The distribution of wins across PG years confirms that the quiz topics and complexity were well-structured to challenge and engage residents at various stages of their training. This initiative successfully achieved its goal of academic engagement across Karnataka.
