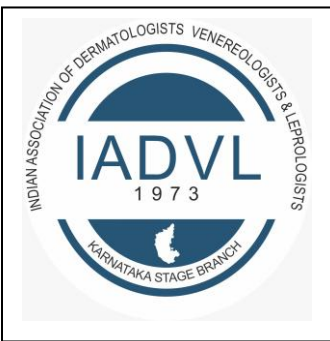

Announcement

The award is aimed at all voluntary initiatives, coming from individuals or departments providing a real benefit to patients. The project must fall within the scope of the community project focused on the patient with the aims to improve its personal wellbeing during **July 2025 and June 2026**.

The scope of the project:

- **Prevention and Education:** Prevention of Dermatological illness and education therapy for patients which can serve in providing Information and promotion of Dermatology.
- **Quality of life and Comfort:** Improvements in quality of life for patients [Physical or Psychological]
- **Access to care and courage:** Facilitating public access to care.
- **Social insertion:** Improved social integration for patients by reducing stigma attached to their disease.
- **Training for health professionals:** Dermatology training of health care workers, nurses, general practitioners

Last date for application submission is **31st August 2026**. The application will be judged by a committee of President, President Elect, Hon.Hon Sec General, Academy Chairperson, Past President KN IADVL. Minimum 50% marks have to be obtained to win the award- in other words, this need not be given mandatorily if a deserving candidate is not available.
